Enjoy special story readings and take pictures with Peter Rabbit from 10 to 10:30 a.m. and 11 to 11:30 a.m. only. Sensory-Friendly Sunday is limited to 250 guests. Tickets are \$11 for museum members and \$16 for non-members. Registration is required.
