Go hands-on with a variety of popular Tangle types, including Tangle Original, Tangle Jr. Totally Textured, and Palm Tangle Metallic. Test your skills trying to read tricky tongue twisters and build a twisty toy masterpiece at craft tables. Turn yourself upside down in a classic game of Twister, which was inducted into The Strong's National Toy Hall of Fame in 2015.
